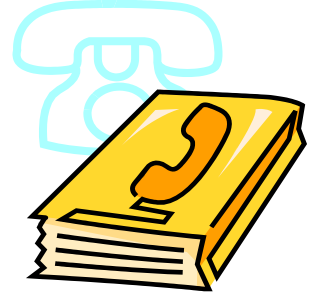

The Division of Social Work Services serves as Middlesex County's comprehensive human services planning entity, allocating federal, state and local funds for social service program and services, such as housing for the homeless, childcare, and other human service needs. The Middlesex County Office of Veterans Services and the Personal Assistance Services Program (PASP) are also Divisions within the Division of Social Work Services. The Office of Veterans Services assists veterans with advocacy and benefits. The PASP provides personal assistance services to adults between the ages of 18 and 65 with physical disabilities, enabling them to maintain themselves in the community. The Office for the Disabled in the Division provides information, referral and advocacy on behalf of disabled people. In conjunction with the Department on Aging and the Middlesex County Sheriff's Department, the Division also coordinates Project Lifesaver, a program that offers electronic monitoring of persons with illnesses, such as Alzheimer's Disease or autism, that cause them to wander.

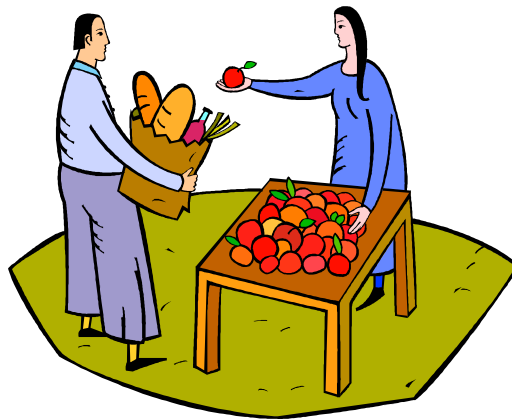

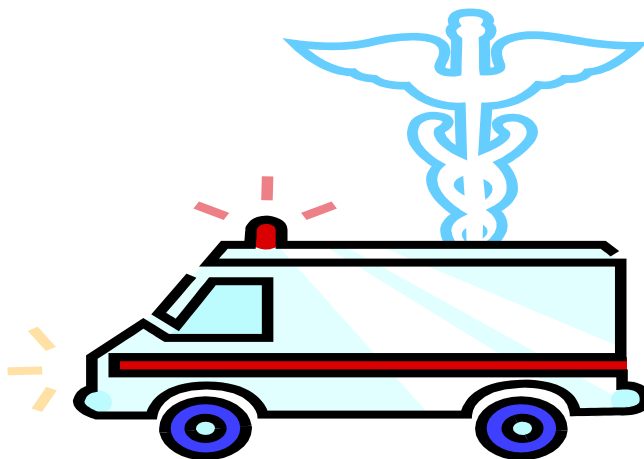
