Types of Batteries Accepted by our Program:

We accept the following types of batteries: Button Cells, Ni-Cad, Nickel Metal Hydride, Lithium-Ion, Lithium, and Small Sealed Lead Acid. If you are not sure about the batteries you wish to recycle please call before you use one of our drop-off locations.

Types of Batteries NOT Accepted by our program:

We do not accept the following types of batteries: Alkaline Batteries, Car Batteries and other Flooded Lead Acid Batteries. These are normally large sized batteries (most are over 2 lbs.). Many individual municipal recycling facilities accept car batteries. Also, many auto-parts stores will take them when you purchase a new battery.
