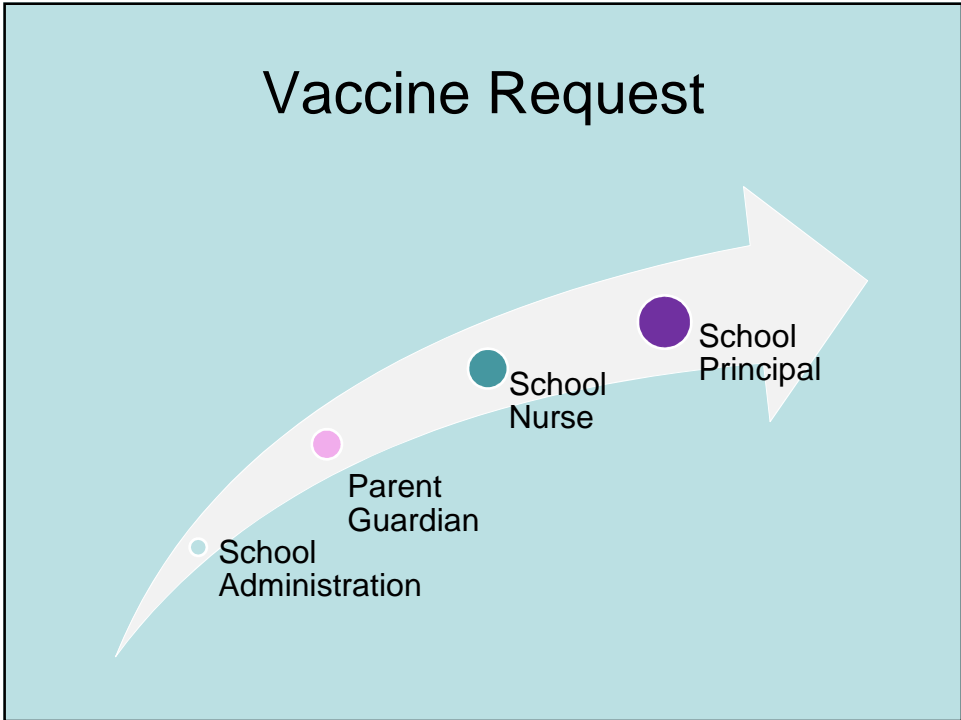
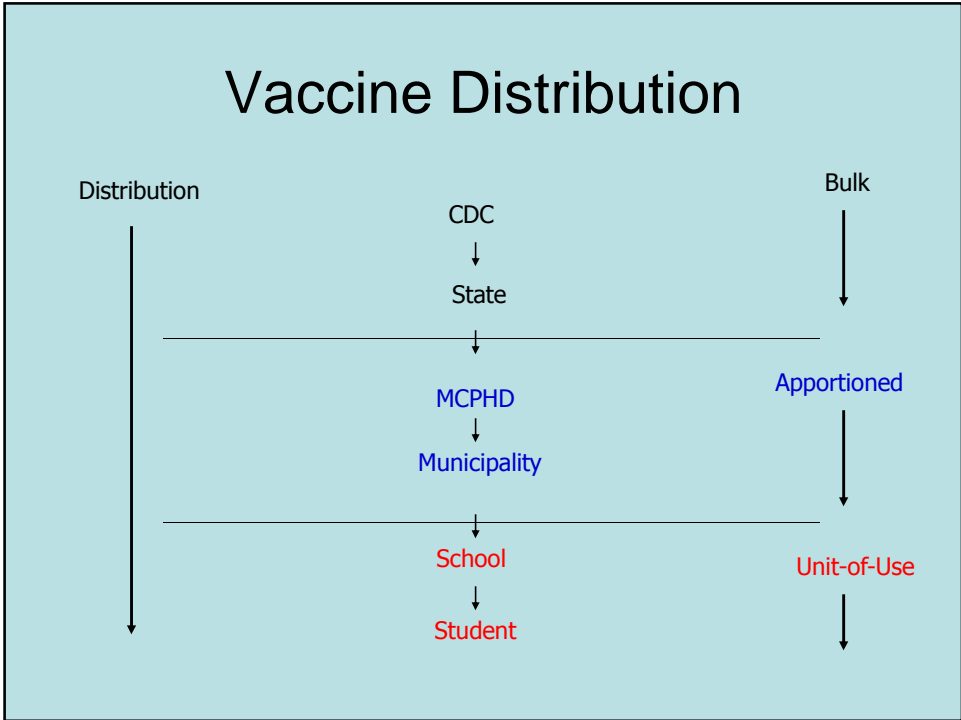

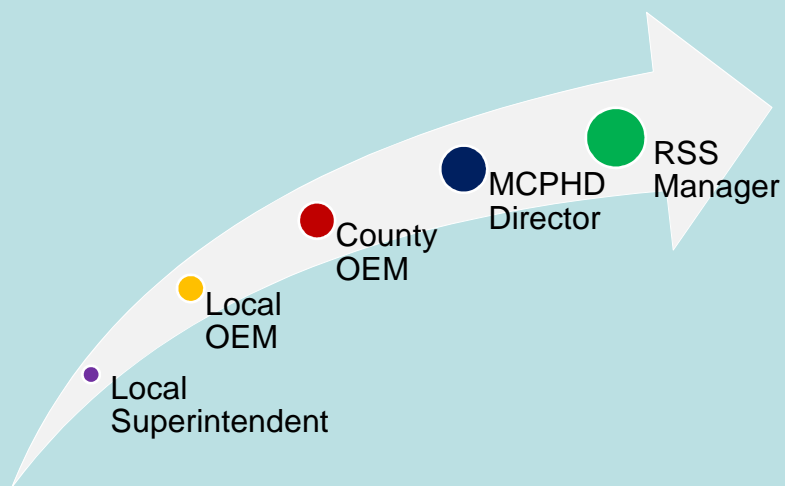
Receipt, Staging and Storage (RSS)
